BLANK'S QUESTIONS: LEVEL 2 (TALK ABOUT IT)

Pages 1-2 (The lady stirring the pot)

- Delicious means that something tastes really good. Where is the delicious stew?
- Finish this sentence: "The lady was cooking a..."

Pages 3-4 (Smell wafting over the city)

- Scrumptious is another word for delicious, it also means that something tastes or smells really good. Tell me some foods that are scrumptious.
- Scent means the smell that something has. Where did the scrumptious scent waft to?

Pages 5-6 (Boy with a truck)

- What colour is her earring? (Point to the lady's earring)
- What colour is the boy's car?

Pages 7-8 (The lady giving the boy some stew)

- Show me the big, pink bowl? (Targeting on)
- Show me the small, blue bowl.

Pages 9-10 (Boy carrying stew down the street)

- What is this bus different from the boy's toy?
- How is the boy using to carry the...

Pages 11-12 (Police officer visiting the lady)

- Why does someone's mouth water, we really like the smell or taste of it. Does the stew they want to eat it. Does the smell of the stew is mouth-watering?
- How is the police officer some stew?

Pages 13-14 (Police officer's badge)

- Show me the police officer's badge? (Point to the badge)
- How is the police officer's badge different from the boy's toy?

Syllable level awareness

Which word has **two** beats?

- Yummy, big, officer
- Apartment, scent, empty
- Share, happiness, grandma

Alliteration identification

Which sound do all these words start with? (We say the sound not the letter name)

- Took, taste /t/
- Seasoned, stirred /s/
- Wafted, window /w/
- Door, down /d/

Rhyme identification

Do these words rhyme? Yes or no

- Car, grandma (N)
- Yummy, scrumptious (N)
- Block, knock (Y)

Rhyme generation

Give me words after me, then shout out your own rhyming words

- Door, saw (Y)
- Love, give (N)
- Blue, do (Y)
